Stripling's Inquiry Model

(School Library Monthly, 4/07 and 9/09)

- Connect (awaken prior knowledge)
- Wonder (generate possible questions)
- Investigate (seek and discover info)
- Construct (discover patterns; draw conclusions)
- Express (create product)
- Reflect (consider effectiveness of process/ product)
